## **Spring Skeet League-2008**

### **GENERAL:**

Each team will consist of 4 people shooting 50 targets per week each, for 12 weeks for a total of 600 targets.

Shooting begins on Tuesday, May 6, 2008. There will be no league event on July 15<sup>th</sup> because of the Wisconsin State Trap Shoot.

The League will be divided into classes (when practical) after the first four weeks of shooting.

The cost of shooting:

- Each Team's buy-in will be \$10.00 or \$40.00 per team
- \$16.00 per 50 targets, per person for Regular Members
- \$18.00 per 50 targets, per person for Special Members  
(Regular membership is \$35.00 per year and Special members pay \$1.00 more per round of 25 until they have shot 35 rounds and then their membership is converted to a Regular membership.)

### **SHOOTING PROCEDURE:**

The Skeet League is scheduled for Tuesdays, other times for shooting league scores are possible but teams are encouraged to shoot as a squad on Tuesdays.

Each round will consist of 50 targets, or two rounds of regular skeet.

A person may shoot as far ahead as desired. Everyone must complete 600 targets by the end of this league, July 29<sup>th</sup>. No scores will be accepted after that date.

### **HANDICAPPING AND SCORING:**

Handicapping will be done on a Team basis. Handicap will be 75% of the difference between a Team's average per round and 100. The fraction portion of the handicap will be dropped.

Teams will be awarded one point for each round won. (Two points per week.) Ties will be awarded  $\frac{1}{2}$  point each.

## **MISCELLANEOUS:**

Replacements on a Team may be made freely during the first three weeks. The final replacement must have shot eight rounds (200 targets) by the end of the first four weeks.

If a Shooter cannot finish the League, The Team Captain may designate another shooter to take his/her place on the Team. The new shooter must be approved by the League organizers. Such a replacement shooter's average and the Team's average for handicapping purposes will be done after each week's shooting in order to be fair for the Team that is competing with them that week for the points to be awarded.

Any Team shooting against a bye will shoot against their own Team's average minus 3 targets per round. That Team will receive no added targets that week.

## **AWARDS AND BANQUET:**

There will be free banquet on Tuesday August 5, at the Club. Prizes will be awarded at this time.

Team and High Gun awards in each class will also be given.

Other awards may be given if they are appropriate.
